

# WEY & ARUN Canal Trust

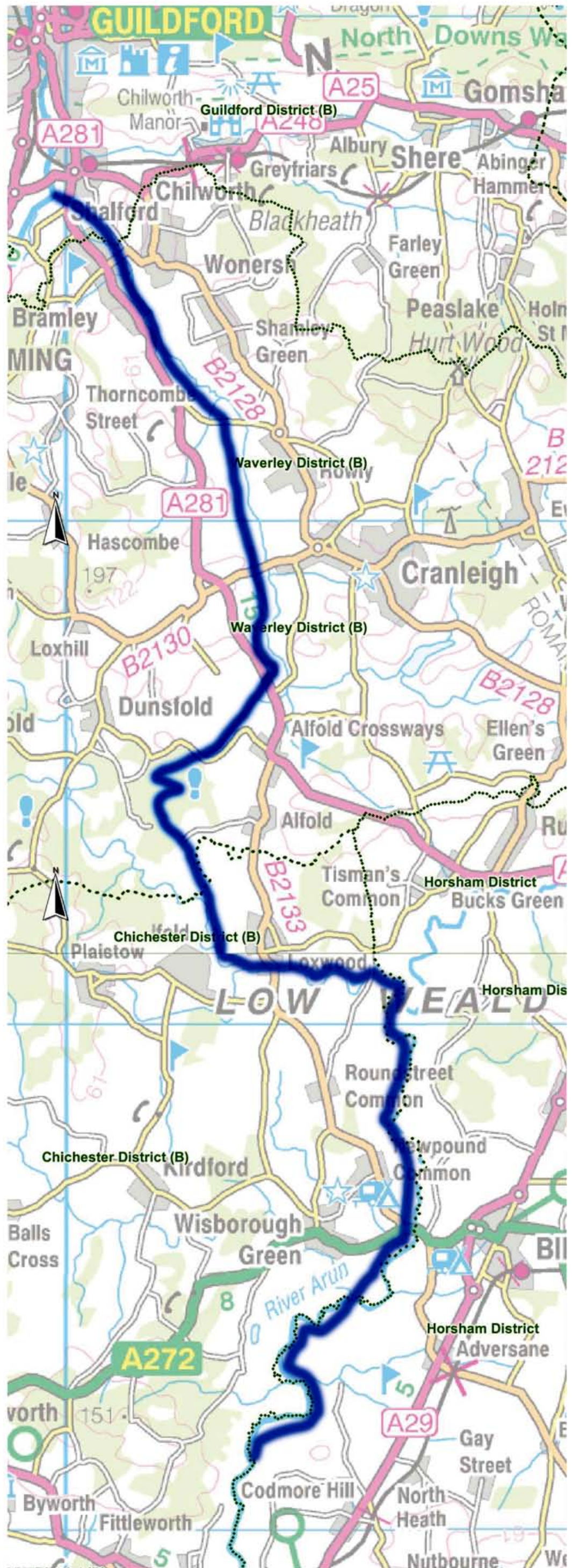
The map illustrates the original route of the Wey & Arun Canal relative to the 4 Borough/District Council areas (from north to south: Guildford BC, Waverley BC, Chichester DC, Horsham DC).

The depiction of the canal route is approximate and is only intended to show the sections of canal route within each Borough/District Council area.

The boundary between Guildford BC and Waverley BC is a short distance south of Tannery Lane, Bramley (at this point the Cranleigh Waters define the boundary).

The boundary between Waverley BC and Chichester DC is about 1km west of the B2133, about halfway between Alfold and Loxwood (the actual boundary is a short distance north of the Border Path).

The canal route crosses the boundary between Horsham DC and Chichester DC several times. The boundary is broadly, but not exactly, defined by the River Arun. The whole canal route south of Orfold aqueduct (about 1.5km SE of Wisborough Green) is in Horsham DC, but there are also two short sections north of the A272. The remainder of the West Sussex section is in the Chichester DC area.
