a 30 mile sponsored cycle ride

The figure of eight route will start and finish at St Catherine's School in Bramley and reaches as far south as Loxwood.

The ride follows the Downs Link and sections of the canal towpath and as the majority is off road, a mountain bike or hybrid is recommended.

The ride will start at 10:30am and is expected to take between 4 and 5 hours to complete.

A minimum entry fee of £20 per rider is required, but additional sponsorship is anticipated.

Every rider who completes the course will be awarded a commemorative mug, but all entry fees and sponsorship money will go towards the restoration of the Wey & Arun canal.
