

Refreshments:

There are several 'Squash Stops' along the route, with hot drinks and refreshments provided at the Finish.

First Aid:

There is a first aid box at the Start/Finish Point, one at the Lunch Stop and one at each Refreshment Point marked on the Route Guide. In the event of an accident, please make your way to the nearest First Aid Point. If you are unable to move, wait for assistance or ask a member of your party to return to the nearest Marshal and ask them to call by mobile phone for assistance.

Lunch:

We are stopping for lunch at the Winn Hall, Dunsfold, where a buffet style lunch will be served. Lunch is paid for by donation into a pot at the end of the table, when walkers can show their appreciation to the lunch ladies for their efforts. A local Beer will also be on sale here.

50/50 Shared Sponsorship:

If you organise a Team of walkers who raise between them sponsorship totalling at least **£150 (minimum £15 each)** we will be happy to share the income raised with your organisation or charity 50/50.

We organise it - you walk it - and the greater the sponsorship then the more we both get. All 50/50 group walkers must complete individual sponsor forms like this one (photocopies of this Sponsor Form are accepted). The Group Leader will also be asked to complete a Team Entry Form, to be completed in advance and brought with you on the day. 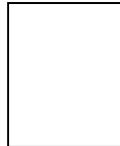

Location :

The Poddle starts this year at The Band Room in Village Way, Cranleigh, opposite the Leisure Centre. There is plenty of parking in the adjacent public car park. The lunch stop will be at the Winn Hall, in Dunsfold.

Eligibility :

The Poddle is open to anyone who raises a minimum £15 sponsorship, although many walkers raise considerably more! The route will be well marked and a detailed Walker's Guide is provided. Please make sure that you are sponsored for at least this much when you arrive at check-in.

We regret that the Poddle is not suitable for pushchairs or very young children as there are usually several stiles and a hill or two on the route.

Dogs are most welcome (especially if they are sponsored!) however they must be kept under control at all times and placed on a lead if necessary and when requested in the Walker's Guide.

The Details :

The walk is 13 miles long. 8 Miles in the morning, 5 miles after lunch. You are free to make your own pace on the walk, as the overall timetable is designed to meet the needs of all entrants. You can start the walk at any time between the hours of **9.00 am** and **10.30 am**.

Check-in closes at 10.30 a.m. when the Last Man team start out.

You cannot start the walk after Last Man team has left.

We hope you will want to complete the whole walk, but it is possible to finish at the Lunch Stop and arrange a lift back to the Start from a lunch stop helper.
