

## SAVE A TREE AND RESTORE A CANAL!

In recent years the income we have been receiving for this method of fundraising has been approx. £4,000 per annum, which is a very useful contribution to our work in the restoration of the Wey & Arun Canal.

We have three skips provided for our recycling merchant, Aylesford Newsprint. Two are located in our car park at the Onslow Arms public house at Loxwood, with the third at the *Family Cook* farm shop on the B2028, Turners Hill Road, Crawley Down.

We do hope to increase the amount collected (over 62 tonnes in 2007) and it is good to know that, in addition to every tonne we collect, Aylesford will make a donation to the Great Ormond Street Children's Hospital.
