Many members and friends of the Wey & Arun Canal Trust have been saving their old newspapers and magazines since we first started this type of fundraising way back in 1974. In recent years the income we have been receiving for this method of fundraising has been approx. £6,000 per annum, which is a very useful contribution to our work in the restoration of the Wey & Arun Canal.

We have a number of skips provided by our recycling merchant, Aylesford Newsprint at the following locations:

- Two in our car park at the Onslow Arms in Loxwood
- The *Family Cook* farm shop on the B2028, Turners Hill Road, Crawley Down.
- Shoots Garden Centre on the northbound carriage way, at Washington, on the A24 London Road.

We do hope to increase the amount collected (over 74 tonnes in 2009, raising around £7500) and it is good to know that, in addition to every tonne we collect, Aylesford will make a donation to the Great Ormond Street Children's Hospital.

Please remember that it is only NEWSPAPERS and MAGAZINES that are acceptable. NO cardboard,, junk mail, etc. Home catalogues, such as Argos, Freemans, Littlewoods, directories, Yellow Pages etc. are VERY acceptable.
